



## Boorowa Sports Fields Improvements Including Lighting

Proposed SCF allocation: \$500,000

### Background

The Boorowa rugby league field is located at the Boorowa Showground and is in desperate need of rejuvenation and rehabilitation. The current field has no lighting and as such limits the use of the field for training and playing purposes during times of low/no light. The field also has considerable wear on the grass cover and it is extremely uneven across the playing field. The current irrigation system does not adequately cover the whole field and as such requires additional watering by Council staff to maintain the field.

The relocation and upgrade of the rugby league field was identified as a priority in the Boorowa Showground Master Plan.

### Scope

The scope of the project is to relocate the existing rugby league field parallel with the new funded amenities building. The new rugby league field would be approx. 120m in length and 70m in width.

The project would include installation of an upgraded irrigation system, top dressing and levelling of the playing surface and replacement of the existing goal posts. If the funding allows, there will be installation of improved lighting on the existing rugby union field and potential establishment of lighting on the rugby league field.
