



Lambing Flat Chinese Tribute Garden

Proposed SCF allocation: \$300,000

Background

The Lambing Flat Chinese Tribute Garden commemorates the Chinese heritage in the region and honours the Chinese who were chased from the Lambing Flat goldfields and who were sheltered at Currawong Station near Murrumburrah. The former Young Shire Council adopted detailed plans for the tribute gardens but were unable to secure funding for the finalisation of the project with different components developed at times different times.

Scope

The scope of the proposed project is to improve the amenity of the Lambing Flat Chinese Tribute Garden and progress towards completion of the garden as per the designs adopted by the former Young Shire Council. Additional funding sources will also be sourced from state and federal agencies. The project aligns with many state and federal tourism plans.
