



Young Tennis Courts

Proposed SCF allocation: \$1,000,000

Background

The Former Young Council had been working with the Young Tennis Club for the past few years to investigate the redevelopment of the site into a regional facility, as a priority for the community. To progress the concept development, the Bowling Club and Tennis Club are investigating consolidation a new and vibrant sporting facility for the Hilltops Region.

The court surface is a high priority, with attempts made by the club to patch the court surface in the past few years, however the existing courts require a more comprehensive intervention to enable ongoing use of the facility. Initial concepts have been completed, however further assessment and community consultation is necessary to determine whether the courts are replaced in situ, or to progress to stage one of the proposed redevelopment with an expectation to identify additional funding sources to complete the project. Tennis NSW have strongly indicated they will provide financial contributions to the project.

Scope

The scope of the project is to improve the Tennis & Bowling precinct and to create a regional sporting amenity with the specific focus of these funds on the tennis courts. Prior to expending any additional funds on this project Council will undertake detailed planning and community consultation to determine the exact scope of works and long term future of service levels provided at the Young Tennis Club.

A decision on the most feasible way to replace the existing court surfaces will impact the final detailed scope of this project.
